

Individual Web Publishing (people.usm.maine.edu)

Overview

All regular USM employees (Faculty and Staff) have web publishing available on their user space (aka the "U: drive"). This space is appropriate for published materials that are more individual in nature, rather than part of a department's official website within the [USM's Web Content Management System, or CMS](#).

Files published here are available to the Internet at <http://people.usm.maine.edu/USERNAME> where USERNAME is your unique user identity.

Publishing on people.usm.maine.edu

Place HTML, CSS, and other files in the **public.www** folder within your user network space. Windows users will see this as **U:\public.www**.

Alternatively you can use the Secure File Transfer Protocol (sftp) to transfer files to your individual web space on people.usm.maine.edu. However, to do this, you need to use **myfiles.usm.maine.edu** as the server or host name.
